



## Allen Mark Dean

Allen Mark Dean of Greensboro, MD passed away on March 8, 2025, surrounded by his family at his home in Greensboro MD.

Allen was born on October 15, 1959, to Howard Dean Jr. and Lillian "Hall" Dean in Easton, MD. He grew up on the eastern shore and proudly graduated from Queen Anne's County High School. Following his graduation, he immediately entered the workforce, farming for various local farmers before joining Tidewater. Over the years, he later became employed at Clinton Nurseries in 2019, where he worked until his retirement in 2022. In his leisure time, he enjoyed playing horseshoes, tinkering with mechanical projects, and was a dedicated lifetime member of the eastern shore community.

In addition to his parents, Allen was preceded in death by two sisters, Patricia and Cynthia Dean, and one stepbrother, James Allston.

He is survived by his partner of over 40 years, Delinda "Dee" Coleman from Greensboro; his son, Christopher Alan Dean, also of Greensboro; two brothers, Michael Howard Dean (Karen) from Queen Anne and Kevin Aldy Dean from Queen Anne; and one sister, Lynn Helen Dean from Easton.
