July 23, 1926 - March 27, 2009

Arthur Everett Ebling, died Friday, March 27, 2009 at home with family in Ridgely. He was 82.

He was born July 23, 1926 near Ridgely, MD, to the late Paul S. and Lillie Cohee Ebling.

One of eleven children, Mr. Ebling grew up, lived and worked around the Ridgely and Greensboro area. He was a lifelong farmer who loved his work. He spent the better part of 50 years farming the Benedictine School farm, transforming it from a money losing proposition to a profitable farming operation starting in the early sixties. Here, he lived and raised his family with his wife until the fall of 2008. He was married to Mildred V. Clark on March 18, 1950 and recently celebrated the 59th anniversary of their marriage.

He was a member of the Calvary Baptist Church in Denton, and although he lived a quite faith, it was nonetheless very real and very dear to him. He had a very generous and giving heart which was displayed continuously throughout his life.
