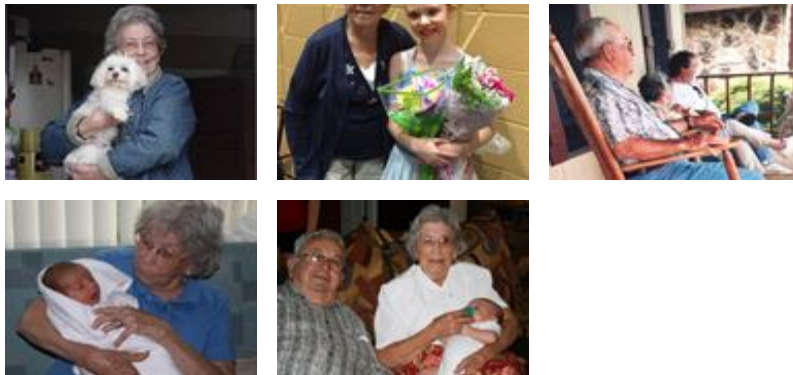

Thanking our Lord for the gentle way he took her home--hoping this gives peace to all the family.

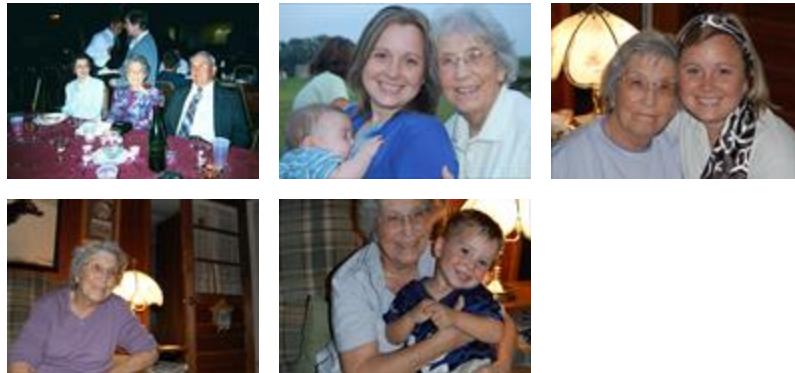
