



## Charles Albert Broseker

November 6, 1943 - August 23, 2025

Charles Albert Broseker, 81 of Greensboro, Maryland, passed away peacefully in his sleep on August 23, 2025, with his family beside him.

Born November 6, 1943, in Baltimore, Maryland he was the son of the late Leonard and Anna Broseker (nee MacKenzie). Charles graduated from Southern High School in Baltimore and served his community with distinction as a member of the Baltimore City Fire Department for 34 years.
