Charles Harding, 76, of Greensboro, MD, passed away November 12, 2024 at Fort Sanders Regional Medical Center in Knoxville, TN after a battle with heart failure.

He was born July 30, 1948 to Hazel Taylor, and raised in the Annapolis MD area, until the family moved to the Eastern Shore of MD in 1966.

Charles joined the Marine Corps, serving from 1968-1969 in Vietnam, where he was wounded on July 4, 1969, during a cease fire.

After a lengthy recovery, he worked for a building contractor for several years, before settling into the Post Office in the mid-70's. He worked in the Postal Service until his retirement in 2002, as Post Master in Greensboro.

This charismatic, hard working, determined, family man had a huge heart for his grandchildren and his animals, including his chickens, which he totally doted on! He enjoyed traveling and was the ultimate handyman.

He is preceded in death by his mother, Hazel Taylor; brother, David Maxwell; and granddaughter, Cassie Hudson.

He is survived by his wife, Margie of 51 years, 5 children: Tammy Ellis (Jimmy); Shannon Hudson (Brad); Beth Davidson (Jeremy); Chad Harding; David Harding (Kristen); 17 living grandchildren; one great grandchild; sister, Karen Patrick; and brother, Alvin Taylor (Kim).
