Charles Edward Johnson, Sr. of Goldsboro MD passed away May 22, 2019. He was 90.

He was born on February 24, 1929 in Oakland, California to the late Charles and Mary Johnson. After graduating from Poly High School in Baltimore MD in 1948 Charles joined the US Army in 1951. He continued to serve our country in the Korean War and was honorably discharged in 1953. Charles moved from Carney MD to the eastern shore and has been a resident of the area since 1977.
