



## Charles W. Lohmeyer

July 24, 1926 - November 3, 2014

Charles W. Lohmeyer, 88, of Denton, MD passed away on Monday, November 3, 2014 at his residence surrounded by his family. He was born on July 24, 1926 in Baltimore to the late Charles F. and Caroline L. Mohr Lohmeyer. Mr. Lohmeyer was a graduate of Poly High School, Baltimore and a WWII Army Veteran. While residing in Baltimore he was a sheet metal worker for the Local Union #100. Moving to the Shore, he started a poultry farm with Perdue. He then became the first network greenhouse grower for Bell Nurseries at the age of 1972. In addition to his parents he is preceded in death by his wife Peggy B. Lohmeyer, his son Raymond Lohmeyer and his sister Doris Scheidt. He is survived by his 5 children Neil Lohmeyer of Ridgely, Craig L. Lohmeyer, Keith C. Lohmeyer and Brian S. Lohmeyer all of Denton and Roxanne E. Lohmeyer of Baltimore, 1 sister Estelle Nelson of Parkville and 6 grandchildren. A funeral service for Mr. Lohmeyer will be on Friday, November 7, 2014 at 11:00 AM at the Fleegle & Helfenbein Funeral Home in Greensboro.
