March 8, 1920 - December 12, 2008

Charles "Smitty" Irwin Smith, died Friday, Dec. 12, 2008 in University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore. He was 88.

He was born Mar. 8, 1920 in Denton, to the late William Kirwin and Sarah Nina Hanson Smith.

Mr. Smith was a 1937 graduate of Caroline High School. He served 8 years in the U.S. Navy and 12 years in the U.S. Air Force retiring as a Master Sgt. in 1960. He was then employed by the MD State Highway Admin. retiring in 1981. He was a member of the Air Force SSgt's Assoc., VFW Caroline Memorial Post #7937, the American Legion #29 and the St. Benedict/St. Elizabeth Catholic Parish.

In addition to his parents he is preceded in death by his wife Margaret Ann (Callahan) Smith in 1978.

He is survived by 5 nephews Gary Cox and Rodney Cordrey both of Denton, Robert Smith of Pennsylvania, Dale Cox of Wilmington, DE, and Stanley Cordrey of North Carolina, 2 nieces Gerrie Baker of Rocklin, CA and Diane Smith of Pennsylvania.
