GOLDSBORO—Clarence Andy Kinnamon passed away on Tuesday, December 17, 2024 at Bayhealth Hospital surrounded by his loving family. He was 87.

Clarence was born at home in Goldsboro, MD and was the son of the late Calvin Kinnamon and Lola (Bickling) Kinnamon. Clarence graduated from Greensboro High School in 1956, and then enlisted in the US Army for two years. He then attended Goldey-Beacom College where he earned an associate's degree in Accounting and Business. He worked at Kent County Public Works for 21 years and also at Sea Watch in Milford, DE for 15 years both in the maintenance department until he fully retired in 2000.
