Clark Hubert Rholetter of Henderson, MD passed away November 24th, surrounded by family, on the farm they moved to from Delaware County, PA in 1976. He went peacefully knowing his work was done.

Clark was born on February 19, 1942, to Burt and Icie Rholetter in Westminster, SC. He spent his childhood in Claymont, DE, where he graduated from Claymont High School. Known affectionately as Clarkie, he began his extensive career at Westinghouse from 1964 to 1985, working as a Machine Repairman at the Lester Branch, in Philadelphia, PA. After his time at Westinghouse, he joined Solo Cup and later became the owner/operator of Rholetter Towing.

Clark, always seeking to learn, had a deep passion for dismantling and repairing items, large or small. When not working with his hands, his quest for knowledge never subsided and he would turn to the pages of his many books. From history books to repair guides or even works of fiction, he loved to read. But one book, The Bible, was always above the rest and closest to his heart. His love for the Lord guided him as a board member of Trinity United Methodist Church and in his work with the Giving Grace Food Pantry, for many years.

Clark was welcomed home by his parents, Burt and Icie Rholetter, as well as his wife, Jeanette (Riddle) Rholetter, his companion in later years, Jane Hart, his brothers Floyd, and Dan and his wife Sally, his sister Evelyn Bartlett and

her husband Bill, his granddaughter Christina Lemon and his great-granddaughter, A'nyiah Faith Rholetter.
