Edward Johnson Ross, 82, of Dover, formerly of Denton, passed away on Friday, January 13, 2017 at Bayhealth Kent General in Dover. He was born on July 24, 1934 in Goldsboro, Maryland to the late William and Evelyn Johnson Ross. A lifetime resident of the area, Mr. Ross was a 1951 graduate of Greensboro High School. He went on to serve four years in the United States Army and worked as a Mill Wright at General Foods. On June 30, 1979 he married Else Adelhelm in Easton, MD. They have two daughters, Shelly A.R. 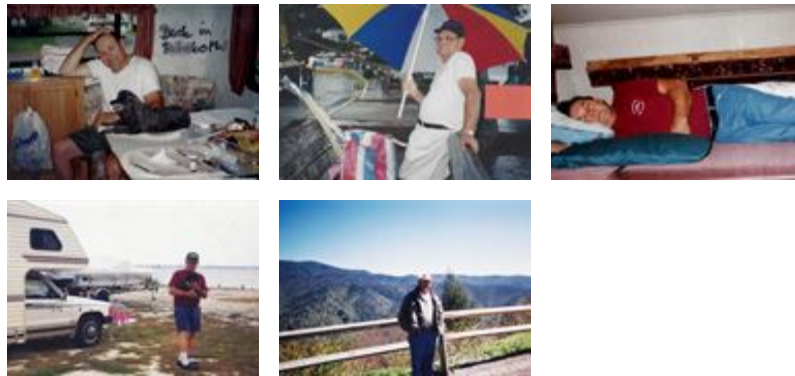
