Eugene "Farmer Gene" Louis Kibler, died Sunday, July 12, 2009 at his home in Greensboro. He was 79.

He was born Dec. 23, 1929 in Greensboro to the late Anne Marie Bradford.

Mr. Kibler was a lifetime resident of the area attending Greensboro High School. He was a US Navy veteran serving during the Korean War. He was employed with James Julian of Wilmington, DE for 17 years. He went on to produce farming, owning and operating Farmer Gene's Produce for many years. He was a charter member of the Greensboro Moose Lodge and a member of the American Legion and St. Benedict-St. Elizabeth Cathlock Parish.
