George Ancel Foy of Greensboro, passed away on November 23, 2016 at Chesapeake Woods, he was 75 years old. He was born in Parkersburg, West Virginia on January 29, 1941 and was the son of Charles Cecil Foy, Sr. and Geraldine Barbara (Adams) Foy.

In addition to his parents he is preceded in death by his son William Curtis Foy, two brothers Samuel Joseph Foy and Charles Cecil Foy, Jr. as well as a sister Eva Diane Hoover.
