Hannah Grace Jones of Denton, MD, passed away on Sunday, March 26, 2017 at her new home in Owings Mills, Md. Born in Easton, MD on July 9, 1995, she was the beloved 21 year old daughter of Chuck and Joan (Collins) Jones.

The most important thing to know about Hannah is that she lived. She lived quietly, gracefully, and bravely. She lived as fully as her body would allow, and did it while loving and inspiring others. Though Hannah could not walk, talk, see or hear, she touched the lives of everyone she met. This began with her own family, but also included her Greensboro Baptist Church family, teachers, therapists, nurses, friends and countless others. Hannah was cared for by so many amazing people, wonderful doctors and nurses at Al DuPont Children's Hospital, the fantastic Dr. Kyle and staff at Bay Pediatrics of Easton, incredible teams of nurses at home with her parents and at her new group home where she moved in January of 2017.

If Hannah were able to express herself, she would, without a doubt, want to share her love and appreciation for her most consistent advocate and tireless caregiver, her Mom. Hannah's medical problems were very often challenging

and difficult, requiring constant, daily attention. Her Mom managed Hannah's daily care with grace and dignity in the face of seemingly insurmountable struggles. Though Hannah 's care was more work than a full time job, she still found ways to reach out to other parents in similar situations, being a light for the Lord and an encouragement to others in the midst of their difficult journeys.

Hannah was one of a kind-created by God to be perfect in every way that mattered. Words cannot adequately express how much she will be missed by her family. Though Hannah is no longer with us, we trust and believe that she is at home in the arms of Jesus, finally able to run, speak, and sing, free of pain and any physical burdens.

In addition to her parents, she is survived by two sisters, Rebecca of Greensboro, MD, and Jennifer Boyer (Robert) of Lynchburg, VA; niece Taylor and nephews Jonas, Logan, and Henry; paternal grandparents Ralph C Sr. and Dorothy Jones of Dover, DE; maternal Grandmother Jean Collins of Middletown, DE; and numerous aunts, uncles and cousins.
