Herman Joseph Knussman, died Saturday, Sept. 5, 2009 at Caroline Nursing Home in Denton, MD. He was 89.

He was born Aug. 3, 1920 in Ridgely, MD to the late George and Theresa Kirsch Knussman.

Mr. Knussman worked as a mechanic for the Caroline County Roads Board retiring in 1982 after 30 years of service. He served his country as a US Army soldier for 3 1/2 years with Company C, 799th Military Police Battalion during WWII, earning the rank of Sergeant. He was a life member of the American Legion Caroline Post #29 in Denton, and the St. Benedict/St. Elizabeth Catholic Parish. He loved to hunt, crab and always had a beautiful garden.
