Jeffery Neil Taylor of Marydel, MD passed away Friday, Jan 24, 2025 in Bayhealth Hospital in Dover, DE. He was 79.

Jeffery N. Taylor was born Jan 31, 1945 in Suffern, NY the son of the late William Edward Taylor and Evelyn Madge “Robinson” Taylor.
