Karen McCauley Edwards, of Greensboro, MD lost her hard fought battle with cancer on September 25, 2023. She was 63.

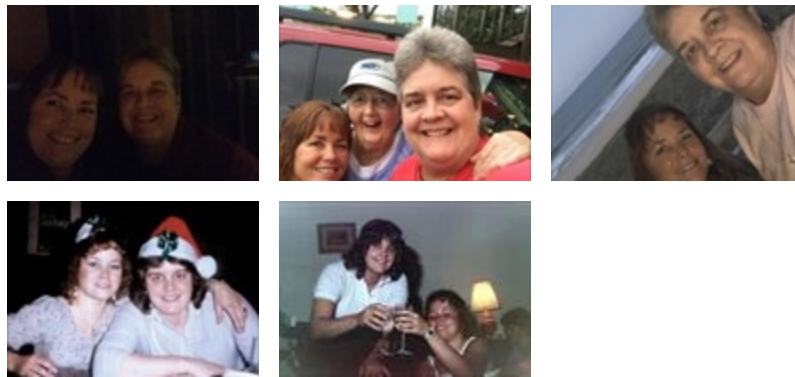

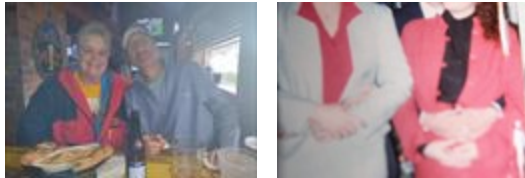
