Leslie "Les" E. Simering, Sr, 89 of Greensboro, MD passed away on Monday, Nov 19, 2012 at his home. He was born on Oct. 5, 1923 in Baltimore to the late Walter and Helen Simering. Mr. Simering was a US Navy WWII veteran, serving on USS McNair, the most decorated ship during WWII. Mr. Simering had retired from Revere Copper and Brass and General Motors, Baltimore as a millwright. He was a member of the United Auto Workers, Local 239 and the Corkers Creek Gun Club of Snow Hill, MD, presently serving as president. He was an avid fisherman, hunter and crabber as well as avid fan of the Orioles, Ravens and Terrapins. In addition to his parents he is preceded in death by his wife Evelyn E. Simering and grandson Jason Simering. He is survived by 3 sons Les Simering, Jr. of Cambridge, Dale Simering of Linthicum and Ron Simering of Denton, 7 grandchildren and 10 great grandchildren.
