Louis Richard Bishop, 92 yr of Camden, DE died on Tuesday, 11/23/2010 at Home, Camden DE. He was born on 04/24/1918 Goldsboro, MD to the late Oscar and Elnora Richard Bishop.

After retiring from farming, he was the Green's Supervisor at the Caroline Country Club in Denton, Maryland from 1964 until he retired at age 62. The founders of the club said that Louis was "the only one who knew how to get the grass to grow." He also found time to enjoy camping with Catherine and traveled to destinations on the east coast in his RV. In recent years, he sold his Maryland farm and moved to Camden, Delaware to be closer to his daughter and family. Louis Bishop was a gentle man, with a positive approach to life. He loved and was much loved by his family and will be greatly missed by all who knew him.
