Marvin Dallas Bolt of Denton, MD passed away on Friday, November 28, 2025 at Eden Green Assisted Living in Denton, MD. He was 90.

Marvin D. Bolt was born in Port Deposit, MD on May 10, 1935, the son of the late Elmer Bolt and Ella (Dehart) Bolt. He graduated from Greensboro High School in 1953 and began working as a milk truck driver.
