October 16, 1913 - October 14, 2009

Mary George Caulk, died Wednesday, Oct. 14, 2009 in Caroline Nursing Home in Denton, where she had been living since April 1997 and had continually received excellent care. She was 95.

She was born Oct. 16, 1913 in Cordova, MD, to the late Elmer Edward and Edith Dyott George.

Mrs. Caulk was a 1931 graduate from Cordova High School. She went on to graduate from Cambridge Nursing School with a registered nursing degree.
