Sonny Skinner died at Christiana Hospital on Thursday, September 15th, 2016. He was born in Charleston, South Carolina, on September 25th, 1935, the son of Myers and Theresa Scarborough Skinner. He is survived by his wife Patty of Goldsboro, two sons, Fred of Lake Worth, FL and James of Miami, FL and his daughter-in-law, Victoria Skinner, widow of his late son, Myers Arthur Skinner. Sonny proudly served in the U.S. Army for 41 years. After basic training he went into the 82nd Airborne and later spent 20 years in Special Forces where he became a jump master.
