Paul Leroy Poore, Jr. "Lee" of Ottsville, PA passed away on Saturday November 25, 2023 at his home. He was 92 years old. Lee was born in his grandfathers farm house near Greensboro, Maryland, the son of the late Paul L. Poore, Sr. and Marguerite Bilbrough. He graduated from Upper Darby High School, Johns Hopkins University and Drexel University with a Masters Degree in Aeronautical Engineering.

Lee served his country in the U.S. Navy as a pilot stationed at Pensacola, Jacksonville, and Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.

He worked at Vertol Helicopters and retired from The Naval Air Development Center in 1993.

Lee served on the board of Plumstead Christian School. He traveled to the Philippines, Germany, and Canada for missionary work projects.

He was a longtime member of The Antique Automobile Club of America and judged many car shows throughout the country.

He is survived by his son, Paul E. Poore of Bedminster, PA, Mary Ann Stauffer of Mertztown, PA and Becky Ritter of Quakertown, PA.

He was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Alta L. (Partin) Poore.
