Raleigh "Rod" Keith Vaughan - dedicated husband, father of five and friend of many passed away peacefully surrounded by loved ones on January 10th, 2023 at the age of 79.

Rod began his life in Elmira, West Virginia on November 2nd, 1943 to Oran Dell Vaughan and Garnet Christine Vaughan (Carter). He was the most loving son, brother, husband, father, grandpa "papaw" and great-grandpa that anyone could ask for.
