



Robert Francis Schreiber

August 23, 1923 - December 17, 2008

Judge Robert Francis Schreiber, died Wednesday, Dec. 17, 2008 at home in Greensboro. He was 85.

He was born Aug. 23, 1923 in Greensboro, to the late George and Pearl Webber Schreiber.

Mr. Schreiber served 2 1/2 years in the U.S. Army during World War II in the Army European Theater as a Military Police Private 1st Class. Mr. Schreiber owned Schreiber's Grocery Store in the town of Greensboro for 25 years. He served on the Orphan's Court for Caroline County from 1955 to 1998. He belonged to the Greensboro Lions Club for 56 years, receiving the Melvin Jones Award in 1999 the Lions highest honor. He also received the Outstanding Citizen Award in 2005. Mr Schreiber was a lifetime member of the Greensboro Volunteer Fire Company and served as a Greensboro Town Commissioner. He was a School Bus Contractor for over 25 years then was the School Bus Driver Trainer for Caroline County from June 1986 to June 1995. Mr. Schreiber was also a member of the American Legion #29 and the VFW Caroline Memorial Post #7937.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his 3 brothers Pete Schreiber, Leonard Schreiber, and Paul Schreiber.

He is survived by his beloved family, his wife of 66 years Mary Matilda "Tillie" Schreiber of Greensboro, 2 daughters Sheila Dean and her husband Marion and Jeanie Schreiber both of Greensboro, 3 granddaughters Lora Stafford of Denton, Christi Leister of Camden, DE, and Paige Cozzi of York, PA, 8 great grandchildren, Morgan Stafford, Riley Stafford, Gracie Dicus, Timothy Leister, Brayden Leister, Catelyn Leister, Nathan Cozzi and Andrew Cozzi, and 1 sister Elsie Embert of Greensboro.

Visitation will be from 3 to 5 p.m. Sunday at the funeral home. Services will be 12:30 Monday at Fleegle and Helfenbein Funeral Home, 106 W. Sunset Ave., Greensboro, MD. Burial will be in the Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery, Hurlock, MD.
