Robert Norman Heath, 85, of Goldsboro, passed away Monday, March 6th in Easton. Mr. Heath was born in Barre, VT on June 11, 1931 to the late Emory and Mildred Thomas Heath. After graduating high school he joined the US Army and worked as an engineer before working as a truck driver first for himself and later for Bill Jones.
