



## Sister M. Assumpta Conti

May 17, 1917 - June 5, 2010

Sister M. Assumpta Conti, died Saturday, June 5, 2010 at St. Gertrude's Monastery in Ridgely, MD. She was 93.

She was born May 17, 1917 in Brooklyn, NY, to Italian immigrants, the late Michael and Assunta Conti and then raised in Philadelphia, PA.

Sr. Assumpta taught on both the elementary and high school grade levels in St. Elizabeth and St. Mark schools of the Wilmington Catholic diocese for many years, retiring from St. Mark High School. After retirement until the day she died, she worked in the finance office of the Benedictine School for Exceptional Children in Ridgely, MD.

In addition to her Benedictine sisters, she is survived by 2 nephews, Raymond Conti of VA and Jack Conti of Pa; 1 niece, Linda Conti of MD; a godson, Rev. Joseph Serano, O. Pream.; and a longtime faithful friend, Rose Marie Curran.
