Sister Miriam Ruth Wilk, died Thursday, Dec. 3, 2009 in St. Gertrude's Monastery in Ridgely. She was 95.

She was born May 18, 1914 in Newark, NJ, to the late Joseph T. and Anna Laczynska Wilk.

She was a 1933 graduate of St. Gertrude's Academy in Ridgely. She joined the Benedictine Sisters on July 13, 1933 celebrating her final vows on August 21, 1937. She continued her education at Seton Hall University receiving her Bachelors Degree in English. She went on to receive two Master's Degrees in English and Latin from Villanova University. She was an educator from 1945 to 1973 at St. Elizabeth High and St. Mark High in Wilmington, DE. She continued working until 1996 at St. Gertrude Monastery and The Benedictine School. She celebrated her Diamond Jubilee, July 16, 1994.

She is survived by nephew, Alex Zozulin & wife Mary Lou of Connecticut, two nieces, Elizabeth Zozulin of Louisiana and Joan Zozulin of New Jersey, one great nephew, and one great niece.
