December 21, 1921 - March 5, 2015

Thomas R. Morris, 93, formally of Greensboro, MD passed away on Thursday, March 5, 2015 at the Delaware Veteran's home, Milford, DE. He was the son of the late Joseph E. and Lillian Reed Morris.

Tom was a Purple Heart recipient who proudly served in the Navy on the USS California where he was stationed during the attack on Pearl Harbor in 1941. He retired after 32 years from Manlove Automotive in Denton, MD, Smyrna and Seaford, DE.

He was predeceased by his wife, Sarah Luella Stufft Morris. He is survived by his daughter, Helen Patricia Hurka; granddaughter, Patricia Jeanne (PJ) Parsons and brother, Rev. Joseph Reed Morris.

Funeral services to be held on Friday, March 13 at 11:30 am at the Fleegle and Helfenbein Funeral Home, Greensboro. Visitation will be a half hour prior to the service.
