



## Willard Marion Sparks

August 8, 1924 - September 27, 2009

Willard Marion Sparks, died Sunday, Sept. 27, 2009 in Envoy Nursing Home in Denton. He was 85.

He was born Aug. 8, 1924 in Cordova, MD, to the late James Oscar and Bernice Evergam Sparks.
